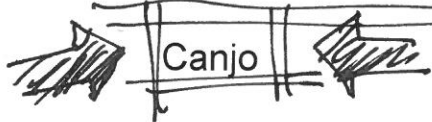

Cut Stick to Length

Rip Tuner Notch

Cross Cut for Tuner

Drill hole for Tuner

Install Tuner

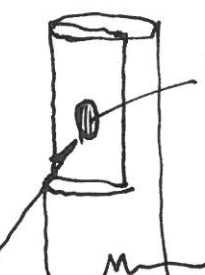
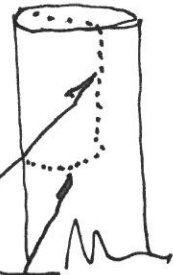
Install Screw for Nut

Drill Holes in Can

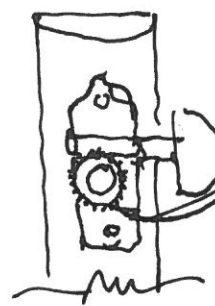
Install Can on Stick

Punch Hole for String

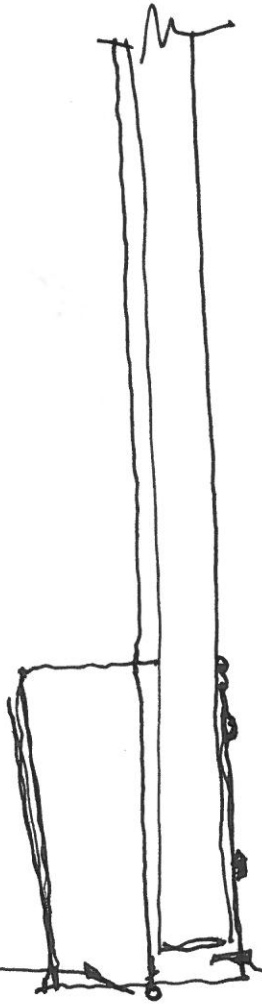
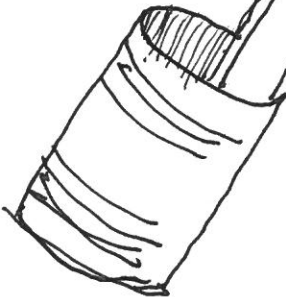
String Up
