6	Palette knife	any metal painting palette knife for mixing china paints, approximately ½" wide x1-7/8" length
7	Spatula	Small spatula (e.g. https://www.dickblick.com/products/lineco-micro-spatula/)
8	Mixing tiles	two cheap white ceramic tiles, smooth (approximately 4"x4")
9	Sifters	80, 100, and 150, 1 ¼-2" diameter https://thompsonenamel.com/product/sifters/
10	Miscellaneous suppliers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Eye dropper • Spray, I use a Hair Spray Bottle Mist Sprayer Fine • Masking tape or blue painter's tape • Green IR safety glasses (recommended) • Optical visors between 2x and 6x (optional) • Old magazines to work over • Any plastic container with lid to keep the paints from drying out on your tiles. • 1 bottle of Isopropyl alcohol – at least 91% • 1 roll of kitchen paper towel • Distilled white vinegar with a cheap plastic container with lid • 2 plastic cups
