1	<u>OPTIONAL</u> : hydraulic press. Will be demonstrated. Students who have a press will see how to use it for creating repeated repoussé forms to be chased.	This is an expensive tool. There are a lot of sources for buying one. Basic Bonny Doon press from Rio is \$1,000. This is a 20ton press with jack and gauge. Potterusa.com basic press is \$1,700. Do not buy a press that is less than 20tons. If you are interested in buying one after seeing the demonstration, please contact the teacher or students who already have one for help and information. 4 or more	¼" by 4" square sheet of CAST acrylic	Specifically for the hydraulic press. If you do not have a press, you do not need this acrylic. Most plastics companies carry this acrylic. Be sure to buy cast as it is much safer to use in a press than extruded (Plexiglass and regular acrylic sheet).		X
