What you will need for the workshop:

Paper.

You can have any kind of paper you have at home or you want to discuss. As matter of fact I encourage you to bring different kind of paper so we callook at them together and see how to choose it. Just to give you few ideas the source could be as easy as some printing paper (colored or white), construction paper, craft paper, shopping bag, magazines, yellow pages.

Even though we will go over how to cut the paper, I would also suggest too have some precut paper strips. The easiest kind to find is the so-called quilling paper. These strips are generally sold in pack of 50 strips 24 inches long. They are generally carried by craft stores like Michael's or Amazon or for a more specialized online quilling stores go to https://quilling.com/ and in particular you can browse this page (https://quilling.com/collections/quilling-strips).

Cutting tools

Small scissors (I like to use nail scissors as they are pointy and small)

And at least one more from the list:

Scissors (t least 4 inch blade)

Xacto knife steel ruler

Cutting mat (self-healing is the best), rotary cutter and ruler

Paper trimmer

Cricut machine

Pasta machine

Herb scissors

•Coating medium and glue

White glue (Elmer's glue or Mod Podge)

Super glue

Other

A jar with some water

Couple of painting brushes
