1 or 2	Pigment/dye	<p>One option is mason stains possibly from your local pottery vendors you need at least one or two colors in mason stains. (black tends to be rich in color and a good first option) amount needed 1-2 ounces feel free to get more if money is not an issue.</p> <p>Another good option is Ceramic pigments from Thompson enamel. https://thompsonenamel.com/product/oc-16-blue/</p> <p>One or two pigments is enough as a start.</p>		x
1	Silver or copper sheet	Either metal would work, 20 gauge is preferred however 18g or 22 would work. You need a sheet at least 4 inches tall by 2 inches wide.		x
1	Silver or copper tubing	At least One 3 mm tubing in either metal. If you are able to have few more sizes like 4mm and 2 mm that would be great		x
10-20	Plastic cups	Plastic cups for mixing (no paper cups do not work)		x
20	Popsicle sticks	For mixing		x
