Student Supply List for Cutting and Forming

- Printer, for printing sawing templates
- Rubber cement
- 2x 20-gauge copper sheets, 6x6"
- Jeweler's saw frame, 4" throat depth
- Jeweler's saw blades, approx. 3/0, dozen
- #65 drill bit, and a larger drill bit or ball bur for de-burring holes
- Flex shaft, drill press, or hand drill
- Chasing or ball-peen hammer
- Center punch
- Torch for annealing, pickle, brass brush
- Sandpaper, approx. 320-grit
- Chain-nose pliers
- Scoring tool**

Student Supply List for Enameling

- Variety of vitreous enamel powders
- Variety of sifters, approx. 1" diameter, various meshes,
- Unscented aerosol hairspray or 60/40 Klyr-Fire/water mix in atomizer spray bottle
- Enameling kiln with at least 4" x 4" interior capacity
- Mesh firing rack
- Variety of kiln furniture/enameling accessories (trivets, kiln forks, etc)
