8	Mixing tiles	two cheap white ceramic tiles, smooth (approximately 4"x4")	
9	Sifters	80, 100, and 150, 1 ¼-2" diameter https://thompsonenamel.com/product/sifters/

10	Miscellaneous suppliers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Eye dropper ● Spray, I use a Hair Spray Bottle Mist Sprayer Fine ● Masking tape or blue painter's tape ● Green IR safety glasses (recommended) ● Optical visors between 2x and 6x (optional) ● Old magazines to work over ● Any plastic container with lid to keep the paints from drying out on your tiles. ● 1 bottle of Isopropyl alcohol – at least 91% ● 1 roll of kitchen paper towel ● Distilled white vinegar with a cheap plastic container with lid ● 2 plastic cups ● a pack of Dap blue Stik-Tak (optional) and a small pad to work on. ● Diamond pads, Alundum stone, or flat file
